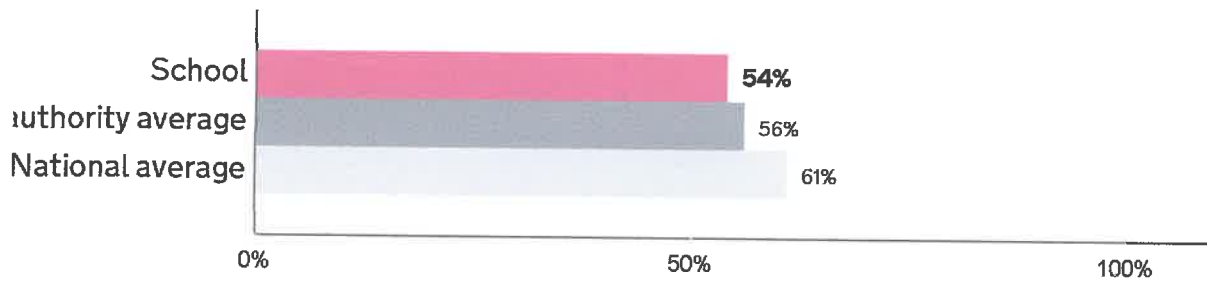

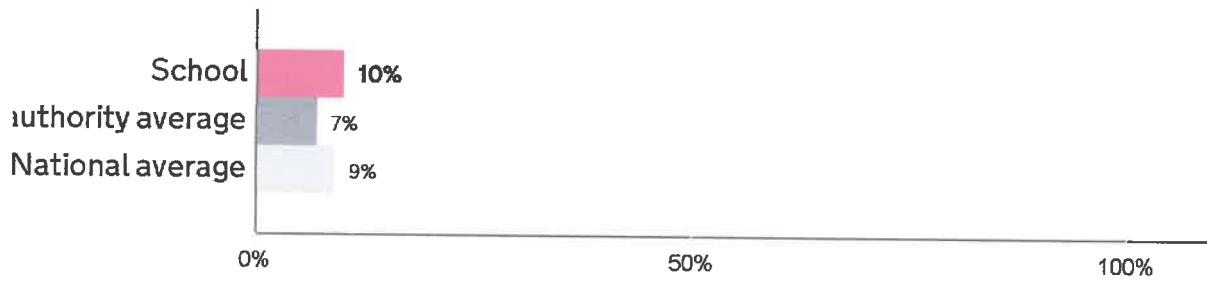
Percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard

Percentage of pupils achieving the higher standard

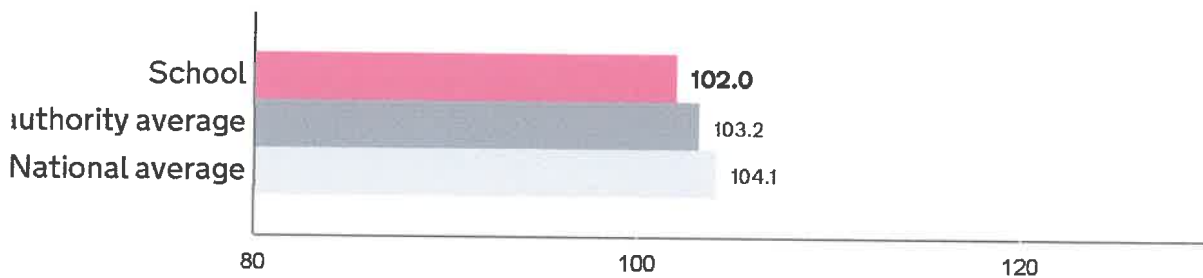

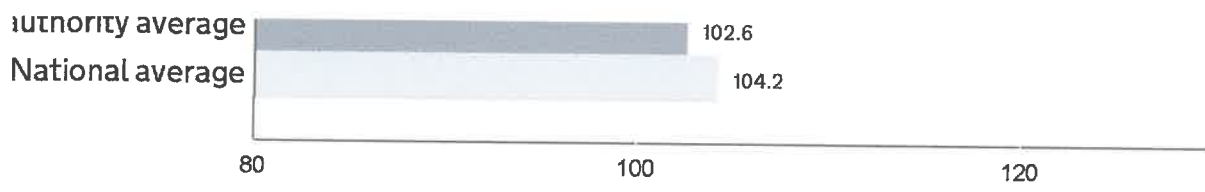
