Dear Parents

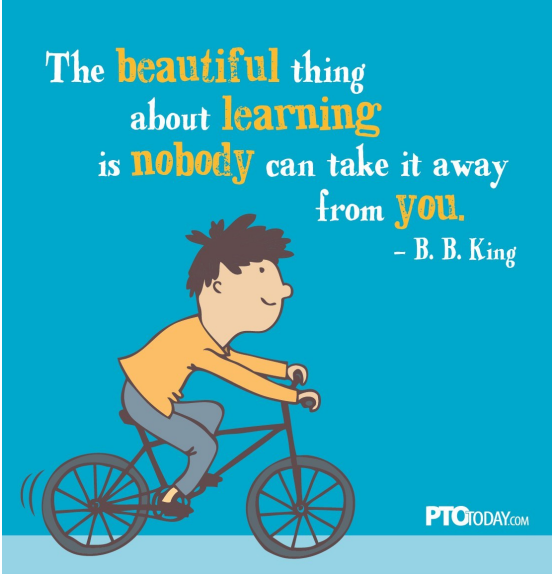
I am delighted to be starting as your new headteacher this week and look forward to getting to know you all over this term. Please do stop to introduce yourself at the school gate.
