Dear Parents/Carers

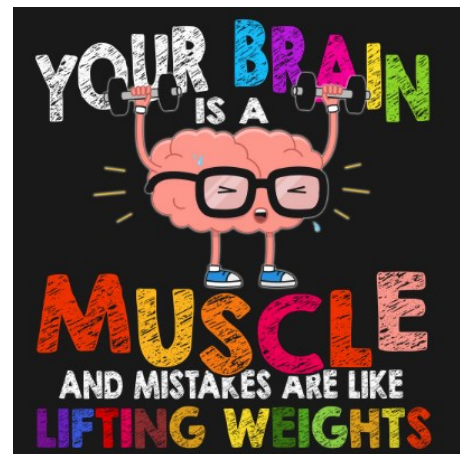
