It was announced today that schools in Wales and Scotland will close by the end of the week and an announcement about schools in England is "imminent." I have no further information to share with you other than this, but in preparation we are sending home our usual homework book along with an additional spare book to keep at home so that any work can be completed in this. Until this time, we remain open as usual.

The information below was sent out at the end of last week, however I am resending this as reminder.

Our principle method of communicating with parents will be via Marvellous Me but we will also update our News section accessible from the Home Page of our [Website](#). Please ensure that you have access to one or both of these so that we can keep you informed. The [Norfolk School Closure](#) website will also provide information about school closures.

If we are advised to close, we will provide work for our learners to complete on our website so that they do not fall behind. All schools are being instructed to provide this. We are in the process of putting together some pages under the [Learners](#) section of our website and will continue to add to and update these. There is some ongoing work already posted and then we shall post additional work weekly during term for completion at home. The Homework Books sent home today can be used to record your child's work. Please do access the [FAQ for Parents section](#) of the site to familiarise yourself with information about how work will be marked or responded to.
