SCHOOL PHOTOGRAPHS

The school photographer will be in school on Thursday 30th September.

- Your child/children will have an individual photograph taken. If they have brothers or sisters at school (including EYFS) they will have a photograph together which is organised by the school, so you just send them to school as usual and you don't have to do anything. **If your child is in 1/2 KR or 3/4 LC please wear school uniform and NOT PE kit.**
- If you have a younger child who does not attend our EYFS setting and you would like a family photograph, please report to the school office at **2.45pm**, so you can collect your child/children for a family photo.
- If you have a child in EYFS who does not normally attend school on a Thursday, you are more than welcome to bring them in at **2.45pm** to be photographed. If they have older siblings in school you can collect them at the same time for a group photograph. You will be responsible for your child/children during this time.
- If you have a child in EYFS who attends on a Thursday afternoon they will have their photograph taken when they arrive and will have a family photograph if relevant.

Obviously, if your child is not in school they will miss the photographer as they do not come back another day.

The photographs will be taken in the hall. Please queue quietly in the afternoon, so not to disturb the lessons nearby and ensure your children queue quietly with you and do not run around the hall. Please use the benches at the side of the hall to sit and wait and maintain a sociable distance from other adults.

If you are bringing younger children to be photographed in the afternoon, please remember this is not a studio and time is not on our side, so please bear this in mind if your child is not cooperating.
