Dear Parents/Carers

Advice about actions to take in relation to Covid 19 – Increase in cases update

I wrote to all parents/carers earlier in the week to request that you remain vigilant as we had a small number of confirmed cases of Covid 19 in school. As this week has progressed, the number of positive cases have increased, particularly in our 3/4 year group and in one Year 3/4 class in particular. I have written separately to the parents/carers in this class.

I have notified Public Health and am continuing to act on their advice. I have not been instructed to close any classes and learners can still attend as normal but we are putting in place a few additional measures to keep everyone safe for the rest of this week.

- We have advised the relevant parents/carers to carry out an LFD test or book a PCR test for their child
- We have increased cleaning schedules
- We have temporarily cordoned off the playground space for the affected class for the rest of this week. This will only cover the next few days and then we will return to mixing on Monday but seems sensible given the high number of concentrated positive cases in this class
- Learners in Y3/4 who remain on Friday afternoons, will still complete a range of activities during the afternoon but will stay in class grouping for this week
- Assemblies have been suspended until after half term to avoid additional mixing.

Should your child be required to self-isolate at any point, provided they are well enough to complete work at home, they can access the online learning on our [Website](#). We also have workbook packs and laptops to lend out if required. Please just contact the school office. Mrs O'Briain (nee Miss Ingham) is currently working offsite and will be in contact with you either via telephone or Marvellous Me to support you with this.

I thank you all for your understanding and consideration during the next few weeks. We are very aware how much school our learners have missed during the past 2 years and are doing all we can to keep them in school and, where this is not possible, to keep them learning.
