Dear Parents/Carers

Re: Plan for This Week

As you will be aware from my newsletter last week, we are surviving on much reduced staffing numbers at the moment and doing all we can to keep all of our classes open if we possibly can. More staff are now isolating or unwell following the weekend. Therefore, we do have a few updates for you.

1. **Multi Skills Competition (Tuesday)** - Fortunately, this is taking place in our school hall on Tuesday afternoon so we are able to continue with this.
2. **Y4 Swimming (Wednesday)** - This has been cancelled for this week due to insufficient staffing. We hope to return the following week, 24th November.
3. **Friday Afternoon** - Once again, we are requesting that you collect your child if you possibly can at 1pm but remain open to those who cannot. Due to the reduced staffing, we have had to move staff hours around to cover across the week. We hope again that staffing levels will be rectified by the end of next week and that we do not need to request this again but feel it is better to sacrifice this rather than close classes mid week.

Please be assured that we are, and will continue, trying to remain open to all but clearly do need to keep this under review. If we do need to close a class, this is likely to be at relatively short notice so please do ensure that you are picking up your Marvellous Me messages. As per government instruction, we have to prioritise face to face teaching for vulnerable pupils, EYFS and KS1.

I ask that parents/carers remain vigilant and test if your child displays any of the [official reportable symptoms](#). However, we are also receiving multiple reports of Covid-19 presenting as sickness in some children so would recommend that you obtain a PCR test for your child if they have any of these symptoms. Regular Lateral Flow Tests are also helpful, if your child is able to cope with these, but please be aware that these are not as accurate as a PCR test and can provide a false negative result.

Thank you, as always, for your continued support. Let's hope things settle again really soon.
