Re: Support for Learning

It is so lovely to be writing to you about something other than Covid guidance for a change! Since we returned to school this academic year, we have been assessing where our learners need a little more support to address time out of school and considering how we can best support them. There have been lots of adjustments to our curriculum, targeted groups and analysis of what is needed. We are delighted that this is having a really positive impact and hope that you can see this too in the books we shared with you last week. Our learners are working hard and rising to the challenge as we knew they would.

This week we will be sending home some additional resources that you may wish to use with your child to help them continue their good progress. These are yours to keep and use as you wish. We fully appreciate that home circumstances are different for each family and that some families may be unable to use the resources currently and that is fine. We've tried to provide things that are motivational and could be played with/used independently or with siblings.

Y1/2 - We will be sending home some spelling flashcards - there are lots of suggestions in the pack about how to use these and activities you can complete.

Y3/4 - We are challenging all of our learners to learn their times tables by heart and earn their 'platinum' badge by the end of Y4. The times table flashcards we are sending home again have lots of ideas about how to use these and games that can be played. These can be used alongside TT Rockstars or Doodle Tables to really embed these facts.

Y5/6 - With our oldest learners, we want to encourage them to keep writing and further develop these skills. Although we are not sending anything home yet... we will be setting some simple writing tasks over the rest of this year linked to what they are doing in class. This might be a poem, diary entry, fact file etc and will be set on Google Classroom. Anyone that completes this challenge will have their work professionally published in our own school books and receive a copy to keep. Additional copies will go into our library to inspire our future learners.
