Dear Parents/Carers

Re: Covid Update

Unfortunately we have not managed to get to the end of this half term without high Covid levels impacting significantly on staffing again. We had done so well up until now with very few staff isolating. However this week is likely to prove a little trickier for us so please bear with us if we are a little slower in answering your queries or your child has different staff covering their class. There are no additional supply teachers available in the West of Norfolk for the rest of this week so our options are a little limited. We started searching at 6am this morning! As always, our priority is maintaining face to face teaching if at all possible. For this reason, we have had to make a few changes to help us get through to the end of the week.

1. Swimming - we have had to cancel Y4 lessons this week due to reduced staffing.
2. Story Club (Wednesday & Thursday session only) - similarly we will have to cancel these sessions just for this week.

Please remember to be vigilant for [symptoms of Covid 19](#) in your children. This includes a high temperature even if you suspect the cause is related to a non-covid illness. If your child has any symptoms, you will need to [access a PCR test](#) via a walk in centre (book online or call 119). Your child cannot attend until they have had a negative result.. A home Lateral Flow Device (LFD) which I know many of you are using regularly, can only be used if you or your child does not have symptoms. I appreciate how very confusing the many changes have been over the course of the last two years and how difficult it is to keep up with them. Please do contact us if you need advice and we will do our best to point you in the right direction.
