## Norfolk Reading Pathway

One in six adults struggles with reading. Research shows that when people read for pleasure they benefit from far greater opportunities in everyday life, education and employment. The Norfolk Reading Pathway is a free programme which is available across Norfolk and is open to any adult who would like support to become a more confident reader. We match learners with one of our volunteer coaches and they work through the 'Yes we can read' handbook together. Coaching sessions are usually weekly for up to an hour. The Pathway is available in all Norfolk Libraries.
