To complement our spring term topic on Explorers, we have invited History Off the Page to provide a Pirate Day in school on Wednesday 10th January. The cost of school trips is becoming very expensive due to the transport costs, so we are aiming to plan in one trip and one school based experience to keep this affordable for all.

The cost of this will be £10.35 per child and you can find an offer on Squid under 'School Activity' category called Year 1/2 Pirate Day. This is a voluntary contribution but we have worked out the cost based on everyone paying, so please bear this in mind as we may have to cancel if we are unable to cover this cost. If you haven't yet registered for Squid, your registration details are attached.

History Off the Page is a company which provides immersive and practical history, science and literature workshops to schools. The workshop, which will take place in the school hall during the whole day, will give us a feeling of what it was like to be a pirate in the 1700s.

On the day, your child will experience life as it would have been on the high seas in the time of Blackbeard the Pirate. The children will learn about the issues of the time, with the opportunity to participate in a range of cross-curricular activities and crafts. The children may keep the items they make.
