

### Zones of Regulation

One of the ways that we are teaching our learners to self regulate, is trying to consider the size of a problem to help them keep things in perspective. This takes practice but is also a useful thing to work on at home.



**Big Problems** - problem that many people share and has no easy, or quick solution. I need some help.

**Medium Problems** - problem that some people share and is able to be resolved in an hour or a couple of days. I might need some help.

**Little Problems** - only affects 1 or 2 people and can be ignored or solved in a matter of minutes. I can ask for help if I need to but might be able to solve this myself.
