We will:

- ✓ provide a balanced curriculum to meet the individual needs of your child
- ✓ encourage and support healthy lifestyles
- ✓ treat everyone with respect and courtesy, giving consideration to their feelings and opinions
- ✓ inform parents of children's progress at regular meetings and share information about what your child is learning
- ✓ let parents know about any concerns or problems that affect their child's work or behaviour
- ✓ listen to any concerns openly and without judgement
- ✓ support families in any way that we can

## The Family

We will:

- ✓ ensure our child arrives and is collected on time at the end of the day
- ✓ ensure our child attends regularly, wide awake and ready to learn
- ✓ ensure our child wears the correct uniform and brings the right equipment to school
- ✓ attend Parent Evenings to discuss our child's progress
- ✓ let the school know about any concerns or change of circumstances that may affect our child's work or behaviour
- ✓ support the school in maintaining good behaviour and discipline, and in showing respect for others
- ✓ support our child in reading and other opportunities for home learning, ensuring that any set tasks are completed on time
- ✓ support our child to behave responsibly on line and monitor their online use to help keep them safe
- ✓ park considerately near the school so that we do not endanger children or inconvenience others
- ✓ speak to the staff calmly and respectfully at all times
- ✓ act as responsible citizens and role models around our learners both on site and in the wider community, including on social media (no comments will be made online that can identify individual staff or pupils)
- ✓ speak to the school first if I have any concerns about my child or the school
