TRANSITION

As you know, in years 1-6, we have three mixed aged and mixed ability classes in each phase group (Y1/2, Y3/4 and Y5/6). For this reason, it is necessary to re-mix classes each year to ensure that they remain equitable and also to group new groups of learners within each phase. A lot of time goes into selecting pupils for each class to make sure they are equal and that each learner has someone whom they work well with. The entire teaching staff have an input into this. Inevitably, whilst many of our learners embrace the challenge of moving up the school, others are less confident and may need support.
