Morning Routines

We are making a few changes to our routines from September. In Years 1-4, learners can be dropped off by parents from 8:35am (up to 10 minutes before school) and go straight into school. We have made this change in response to more of our learners needing support to manage the transition first thing. We hope this will make the start of the day easier for some. The downside to this is that your child's class teacher will not be available to speak to at the beginning of the day as staff will be needed in class. Phase Leaders (Mrs Rose and Miss Rogers) will be outside to pass on any urgent messages or you can speak to your child's class teacher after school. Pick up will continue to be from the playground as normal.



Y5&6 will continue to wait in the car park area, again from 8:35am, once staff are on duty. Please do not arrive too early. This is part of our transition planning in preparation for High School. Our learners also value the opportunity to chat to friends prior to peeling off to go to different classes. It will be busy at the beginning of term by the car park gates so, if you are waiting for your child to enter school, please wait inside the gates once staff have closed this to traffic. Once some of our Y6s start being given the responsibility to walk to and from school by themselves, this is no longer an issue but we appreciate at the beginning of term, it is likely to be busy.

Gates will shut promptly at 8:45am by which time, your child should have arrived at school. It can be difficult getting back into routines after a lengthy break. [Just One Norfolk](#) have some handy tips and advice to help you and your child manage this effectively and is well worth a look.
