At the end of term, over 150 pupils had a Summer Term 100% Attendance Treat - this is definitely something to celebrate! Our overall attendance for the 24/25 year was 96% compared with a national attendance of 95%. Keep up the good work everyone!

If your child was in the Persistent Absence bracket last year (below 90%), we are planning to contact you early on this term to discuss how we can work together or support you across the coming year. ## Home Learning Years 1 to 6



Please bear with us over the next week whilst teachers read individually with your children and allocate book levels. Home Learning tasks will then be sent home the following week.

In Y3/4 we will be asking parents to use our online homework app (Learning with Parents). This was very well received and proved successful last year. For pupils moving into Y5/6 they will again have Book Marks issued. We are mindful that learners higher up the school need to develop greater independence to complete home learning themselves in preparation for High School. However, we will be able to share some other resources that parents may wish to use to supplement this at the upcoming Drop In Session.

Doodle Maths is used from Y1 to 6 and ask all learners to access regularly across the week. Just 10 minutes a day will make a big difference.

- \* Family issues - bereavement, new siblings in the family, parent separation/divorce


## School Rewards

We have lots of rewards and incentives in school that our learners can work towards. In EYFS learners work towards earning stickers - I'm sure you'll see lots on their tops when they come home each day. From Y1 up, learners are awarded "Terries," for effort in their work, good behaviour or being kind and helpful. When they achieve 50, 100, 150 Terries, they can swap these for a small gift (Y1/2) or a special treat from Y3 up. A treat might be for an example, be sitting on the teacher's chair for the day, or hot chocolate at snack time or wearing non-uniform for the day. We celebrate good work and also learners who demonstrate a [Growth Mindset](#) in our weekly assemblies with certificates.

We also have a number of badges that our learners can earn throughout the year. Badges and a "treat" are given to any child who achieves 100% attendance each term. Learners in all years are also set a challenge to read 20 age appropriate books (or share in EYFS) through the year to earn their reading badge. We also want our learners to earn their Bronze, Silver, Gold and eventually Platinum Times Table Badges. More information is on our [website](#).

## Learning to Thrive Curriculum

We have started the year, discussing the Zones of Regulation which we introduced to our learners last year. Learners lower down the school are continuing to practice recognising their emotions and identifying how they are feeling whilst in KS2 we are building toolkits so that we have lots of tools to help us self-regulate.



We teach our learners that no emotion or zone is "bad" - we all experience them but we also need to develop skills to manage our big emotions. You can find out more about this on the [Just One Norfolk website](#).
